Minutes of the General Meeting Febuary 7, 2012

Guests:

Girl Scout Troop 30572: Troop leader Stephanie Haley and scouts Molly, Emily, and Sami proposed a rock painting mural promoting staying active outdoors; focusing on health and activity. Also, they proposed a geocache and letterbox project that works like a treasure hunt. Three caches, or small boxes, along the trail will offer little prizes and also clues that lead to the mural. Geocaching is an international outdoor activity.

There were misc. questions about the mural and the geocache project. Reno DeLuzio moved to support the project, seconded by Dave Cassinelli. Passed unanimously. No expenditures required.

Lauren Carroll, American Heart Association wants to AHA-brand the trail as a resource for www.startwalkingnow.org. We can list the trail as a resource on this site. AHA members will walk the trail and confirm that it meets their seven criteria for branding. Lauren will publish the trail on site for us. AHA will purchase two signs, one at the beginning and one at the end. The program is nationally sponsored by United Health Care. There was special interest in the downloadable smart phone application giving users mileage, location, etc. AHA will provide signs.

Reno DeLuzio moved to support the project, seconded by Ed Eck. Passed unanimously. Dave C. and Nancy Wojick will work with Lauren to install the signs.
